**\*\*\*THE IMPORTANCE OF SOLFEGE:**

Solfège is the language of the well-educated musician. When we sing the solfège syllables while reading notes or playing the keyboard, we develop a strong sense of tonality and relative pitch. Each solfège note sung strengthens the connection between what is heard, what is seen and what is played. Singing solfège teaches us to internalize the music. With time, and practice, you and your child will begin to hear the notes that you read before those notes are even played on the keyboard.
