<p><u>FINGER EXERCISE</u> <i>What you should already know # 1 - 2 - 3 - 4</i> <i>What you should be able to do by next week:</i> #5: Play Do... Mi...Sol with your Left Hand Play Do...Mi...Sol with your Right Hand Cross LH over RH and play the next-higher Do</p>						
<p><u>ODE TO JOY</u> <i>PREPARE FOR YOUR SOLO!!!!</i> Practice for next week's solo by playing Hands Together with the CD. If you mess up, stop the CD and practice the part that messed you up. Then try again. By next week, you will be ready!</p>						
<p><u>LARGO</u> <i>What you should already know:</i> Play Left Hand alone measures 1 - 8 & 17 - 24 - try it with the CD Play Right Hand alone measures 1 - 8 & 17 - 24 - try it with the CD Sing and play Hands Together measures 1- 8 <i>What you should be able to do by next week:</i> Sing and play Hands Together measures 17 - 24</p>						
<p><u>MARCH IN C MAJOR</u> <i>What you should already know (just do every day)</i> Point and SING along with the CD Play whole song Left Hand - with the CD</p>						
<p><u>MARCH IN A minor</u> <i>What you should be able to do by next week:</i> Point and SING along with the CD <i>What you should be able to do by next week:</i> Play the Left Hand (it's the same notes as Down By the Station in A minor!)</p>						
<p><u>ANGRY</u> <i>What you should already know (just sing every day)</i> Point and follow along with the CD Sing measures 1 - 8 by memory</p>						
<p><u>DOWN BY THE STATION IN C MAJOR</u> <i>What you should already know</i> Sing the words and play the Left Hand chords with the CD</p>						
<p><u>DOWN BY THE STATION IN G MAJOR</u> <i>What you should already know</i> Sing the words and play the Left Hand chords (try it with the CD)</p>						
<p><u>DOWN BY THE STATION IN A MINOR</u> <i>What you should already know</i> Point and sing along with the CD Play "La-Do-Mi and Sol-sharp-Re-Mi" with your Left Hand <i>What you should be able to do by next week:</i> Sing the words and play the Left Hand chords slowly and carefully</p>						
<p><u>SLAM DUNK</u> <i>What you should already know (just play every day)</i> Point and sing along with the CD Play each "Slam Dunk" (in the circles) five times each <i>What you should be able to do by next week:</i> Play each "Slam Dunk" followed by the "Do" right after it (read the practice pointers first)</p>						
<p><u>OLD GERMAN DANCE</u> <i>What you should already know (just do every day)</i> Point and sing along with the CD</p>
