<p><u>LONDON BRIDGE IN G MAJOR</u> <i>What you should already know:</i> Point and SING along with the CD Play Left Hand alone (watch out for Fa-sharp- Re) <i>What you should be able to do by next week:</i> Sing and play Right Hand measures 1 - 4 with correct fingers Right Hand finger number 4 goes on high Re</p>
