<p><u>LARGO</u> <i>What you should already know:</i> Point and SING along with the CD (remember - the optional part is OPTIONAL - you don't have to do it) <i>What you should be able to do by next week:</i> Sing and play the harmony On the first page, play the Right Hand - same notes as Rocking Horse in G On the second page, play the Left Hand - same notes as Rocking Horse in G</p>

<p><u>LONDON BRIDGE in G MAJOR</u> <i>What you should already know:</i> Sing and play Right Hand measures 1 - 4 with CORRECT FINGERS practice WITH THE CD <i>What you should be able to do by next week</i> Sing and play Right Hand measures 5 - 8 with CORRECT FINGERS Sing and play Left Hand whole song (same notes as Rocking Horse in G)</p>						
<p><u>THE DARK FOREST</u> Prepare for your solo by singing and playing WITH THE CD</p>						
<p><u>ROCKING HORSE IN C MAJOR</u> Prepare for your solo by singing and playing WITH THE CD</p>
