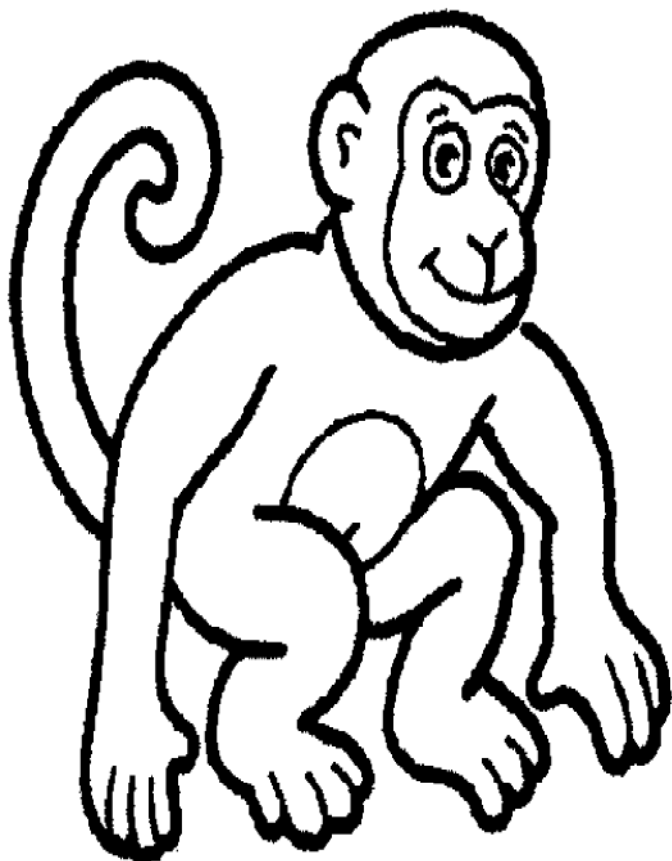


A FUN PICTURE TO COLOR!

LET'S PRACTICE OUR RHYTHM!

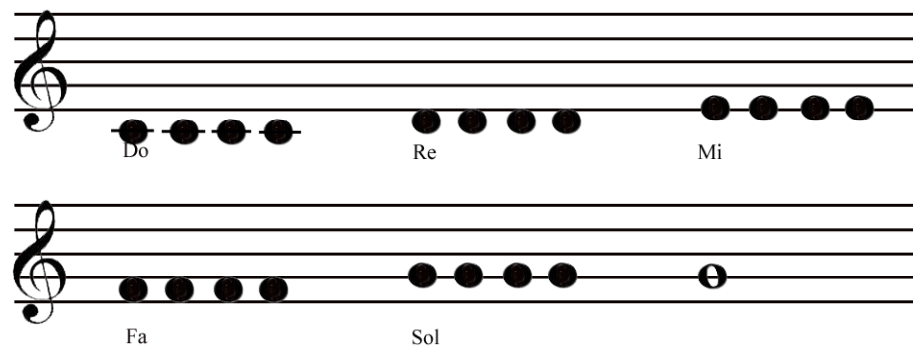
Clap and say this rhythm
