

Practice this whole page every day:

	DAY 1	DAY 2	DAY 3	DAY 4	DAY 5	DAY 6
<u>SIGHT READING</u> Week 7 - Do EVERY step EVERY day Practice until you can sing and play step 5 with your hands covered						
<u>HANON</u> Put your Palm Pom on your Left Hand. Play LH alone up and down. REALLY CONCENTRATE on playing with round, strong fingers - especially, the last little bend on each finger. 						
<u>SCALES AND TWO HAND CHORDS</u> C, Am, G, Em, F, Dm two scales every day	C Am	G Em	F Dm	C Am	G Em	F Dm
<u>THE PEDDLER</u> Point and follow along with the “point and follow” music Listen very carefully while you point Work on filling in the song: 1. write the counts 2. draw a line straight down from all of the #1s 3. Use your chord chart to write the correct chord names, notes, and finger numbers						
<u>COMING ROUND THE MOUNTAIN</u> Work with the “play along” music Do a little bit each day. Do NOT stop the music when you mess up. Instead, let the music play and just sing along						
<u>PARADE OF THE TIN SOLDIERS</u> OPTIONAL song - learn it if you like, but it is not required Point and SING along with the “point and follow” music Play Left Hand BLOCK CHORDS (9 - 12 are the same as 1 - 4 - BUT they are higher on the keyboard)						
<u>FOLK DANCE</u> Play LH WITH the “play along” music Sing and play Hands Together 1-26 Sing and play Hands Together measures 27-38 Remember to work on little bits each day Not the whole thing on the first day!!!						
<u>POLKA MAZURKA</u> Play Left Hand fancy style with the “play along” music every day Sing and play Right Hand measure 1-4 Try measure 5-8 - I think you can do it! Sing and play Right Hand measure 9-12 Sing and play Right Hand measure 13-14						
<u>RUSSIAN DANCE</u> Play Left Hand with the “play along” music Sing and play Right Hand with correct fingers Start working on H.T. - remember to work on small sections (1-2 measures) each day.						
<u>SARABANDE</u> Point and SING along with the “point and follow” music

Please check on weekly progress by asking for random performances of items on this list.
